



High School Scholarship Guidelines

PURPOSE:

The First Missionary Baptist Church Moody Scholarship Ministry's purpose is to assist our high school graduates in their pursuit of higher education through a college, university, or technical school program.

ELIGIBILITY:

In order to be eligible to receive the FMBC High School Scholarship, applicants must meet each of the following requirements:

- Applicant must be a prospective high school graduate in the year of application.
- Applicant must be an active member for a minimum of six months prior to the receipt of the scholarship.
- Applicant must be active in at least one church ministry for at least 6 months prior to the receipt of the scholarship.
- Applicant must complete the application packet.
- Applicant must submit a copy of high school diploma.
- Applicant must provide a copy of registration/tuition bill from the school prior to the release of funds.

Gift Guidelines

PURPOSE: Recognize, reward and/or encourage high school graduates to pursue a higher education upon graduation.

NOTE: An inactive member may receive a gift at the discretion of the scholarship committee with approval from the Pastor. **If you think you are ineligible for this scholarship, apply for the scholarship and allow us to find a way to help you in your pursuit of higher education.**

Application Document Checklist:

- __ Send FMBC Education and Scholarship Ministry (eddie@bakerslearningkitchen.com) the date of the high school's senior award day
- __ Data Sheet completed in blue or black ink or typed (**preferred**)
- __ Copy of high school diploma (**Once received...Your senior guidance counselor can sign and date a letter stating you are on track to graduate**)
- __ Copy of resume (**Must be reviewed by the ESM before submission**)
- __ Documentation (registration/tuition bill) from college, university, or technical school program (**Must be provided before funds are released**)
- __ Typed essay of 250 words or more (Must be reviewed by the ESM before submission and recipients may be requested to orally present their essay. Please do not forego submitting the application out of fear about publically speaking. We will work with you if you are requested to orally present your essay).

Essay Guidelines:

- Typed in MLA (Modern Language Association) format, on white 8 ½ X 11 inch paper
- 12 point font
- Times New Roman
- Double-spaced
- 1 inch margin

Essay Topics for General Scholarship: 250 words (Choose One Topic)

- How advanced / post-high school scholarly training will contribute to your role as a Christian?
- How have the FMBC ministries contributed to your personal growth as a Christian?
- How will you transform to the best version of you in 2022 and into college?

Timeline:

- **Friday, April 22, 2022** – Potential applicant(s) should provide the high school awards' day date to the FMBC Education and Scholarship Ministry (Deacon Eddie Baker, III). FMBC General Scholarship Awardees will be announced during their respective high school awards days.
- **Sunday, May 01, 2022 by 10:00pm – Applications and associated documents are due**
