

FMBC Moody Continuing Education Scholarship In Honor of Deacon Eddie Cason Baker (ECB), Jr. Scholarship Guidelines

PURPOSE:

The purpose of the FMBC Moody Continuing Education Scholarship is to assist our members in their pursuit of higher education through a college, university, or technical school program. This scholarship is open to any member of FMBC Moody who meets the eligibility guidelines.

Deacon ECB Jr. was a faithful, FMBC Moody member and he unexpectedly passed on July 31, 2010. Deacon ECB Jr. made a positive impact on many people (inside and outside of the church) and some say that he never met a stranger. One of his favorite quotes was "to whom much is given, much is required" and one of his favorite songs was "I Won't Complain." Deacon ECB Jr. did not have a formal college-degree, worked for a manufacturing plant for approximately 32 years and attended night school to pursue his Commercial Driver's License as the manufacturing plant was downsizing. Prayerfully, this scholarship will help someone pursuing their transition moment and also help catapult them into a place where they can provide for their family and give back to others.

ELIGIBILITY:

In order to be eligible for the FMBC Moody Continuing Education Scholarship, applicants must meet each of the following requirements:

- Applicant must be an active member and active in at least one church ministry for a minimum of one
 year prior to the receipt of the scholarship. Exception: Current higher education student attending
 school out of area (45 miles or more from FMBC Moody).
- Be pursuing a higher education through a college, university, or technical school program.
- Applicant must submit an email of intent on applying for the scholarship, complete the application packet and participate in the scholarship interview.
- Current college students or current year high school graduates must have a G.P.A. of 2.5.
- Applicant must submit a copy of their and use the FMBC Moody Personal Reference form to provide 2 personal references.
- Applicant must provide a copy of the current registration/tuition bill from the school prior to the release of funds.
- Applicant must submit one photo head shot high resolution (3 x 5) on photo quality paper.
